Subject: Fork Lifts

To qualify for Class E rating on the fork lift attachment, it will be necessary to incorporate stops for the forks and install an identification plate.

The fork lifts that have been shipped to you require these modifications.


The required quantity of stops and plates is provided. Please submit attached warranty claim for this work in the amount of 30 minutes for the plate addition and 30 minutes for installing stops.

General Electric will also pay travel at the rate of 25¢/mile for the first 25 miles, then 15¢/mile for mileage over 25 in those instances where the fork lift has been sold and travel is required to do the work. The fork lift will not have to be brought to the shop for this correction.

We request your cooperation in assuring that these modifications are made by July 1, 1973.

Also included is a Fork Lift Use and Care Manual that is to be forwarded to each fork lift owner. In addition, price lists are forwarded providing prices for the complete fork lift package (including overhead guard and counterbalance) which is required for compliance to fork lift safety standards.
