A special offering is being made to Outdoor Power Equipment Operation employees so that those who wish can become Elec-Trak owners at substantially reduced prices. In making this offer the Operation expects to learn more about the product through the actual experience of knowledgeable employee-owners who will be required to make a regular report on the operation of their machines throughout their period of employment and ownership.

The following terms and conditions will apply and should be carefully considered and thoroughly understood by anyone wishing to participate:

1. Only Model E-15 tractors with heavy duty batteries will be available. These will be new machines, or ones operated for a short while on test. These are offered at \$715 picked up here. The mower will cost \$160 and all other accessories can be purchased at 25% off the retail price (dealer cost). All prices are plus applicable sales tax.
2. Full payment may be made in cash at time of delivery for the price of the tractor and accessories. Accessories (one of each) can be purchased at 25% off the retail price at any time. For those who wish, payment may be made by payroll deduction of the balance remaining after a downpayment of one-third of total price (on original purchase only). The deduction period will be 12 months at an additional cost of 6% of the original amount financed. It must be understood that any outstanding balance will be paid in full if the purchaser leaves OPEO for any reason (including transfer to another General Electric department). Alternatively, the tractor and accessories may be returned during the 12 month payment period and the amount paid through payroll deductions -- but not the downpayment -- will be refunded. The regular employee discounts will not apply to purchases made under this special offering.
3. Pick-ups will be at Building 803. Purchasers will be expected to make their own delivery arrangements. For those who wish to do so, OPEO trailers or trucks will be made available, when it will not interfere with normal business operations. Employees will be held responsible for any damage to OPEO equipment and will be expected to return it promptly. These arrangements should be made through Rod Paull, Building 803 - extension 5-6503.
