PERSONAL ACCIDENT INSURANCE

The rate for Personal Accident Insurance will be increased for the policy year beginning July 1, 1972 to 55 cents per thousand dollars of coverage as a result of unfavorable claim experience during the current policy year. This is an increase of 5 cents per thousand from the current rate. Despite the increase, the rate is still a Best Buy for this type of 24-hour Accidental Death and Dismemberment coverage.

Under the terms of the Insurance, participants have their coverage renewed automatically with the first deduction, based on the revised rate, taken from the last pay in June.

Enrollment cards were distributed to all participants today. Those who want to change their rate of participation should complete and return these cards to payroll promptly.

Presently there is over \$5.2 billion of coverage in force under this Insurance.
