INSTRUCTIONS FOR SAFE MOWING

MOWER DELIVERY

1. Be sure that the mower you buy conforms to the requirements of USA Standard B71.1-1968.
2. Check to see that you have detailed starting and operating instructions.

TRAINING

1. Never allow children to operate power equipment.
2. Learn how to stop the mower and tractor quickly.
3. Instruct children to stay away from the equipment while it is in operation.

PREPARATION

1. Before mowing, clear area of debris.
2. Set mower at highest cutting height when mowing in rough ground or in tall weeds.
3. Mow only in daylight or in good artificial light.
4. Do not operate mower in wet grass.
5. Do not operate mower with guards removed.
6. Wear substantial shoes and long pants while using mower.
7. Check power cords on electric mowers for cuts or breaks.

OPERATION

1. Give complete and undivided attention to the job at hand.
2. Do not start mower in the vicinity of other persons.
3. Stop the mower and tractor before you leave the operating position.
4. Use caution when operating the equipment on uneven terrain.
5. Do not carry passengers.
6. Remove power cord and check for breakage and repair any damage after striking foreign object.

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

1. Follow maintenance instructions given in the owners manual.
2. Have your ELEC-TRAK dealer inspect the mower each year.
3. Disconnect the power cord before making any adjustment or repair.
4. A well-maintained mower operated correctly will produce best mowing results.
